This policy will be communicated to all persons working on behalf of the Clipfine group of companies and is available to the public from our website.

Clipfine is committed to comply with applicable legal and other requirements which relate to the environmental aspects all Clipfine Group of Companies business activities, products and services.

Through the management framework of our established environmental management system we assess each activity, product and services of Clipfine Group.

We identify each activity related to every product and service and evaluate the potential to interact with the environment (the environmental aspects). We apply a risk management approach in order to identify the potential to cause harm to the environment. We assess the probability and the severity of actual or potential impact in normal, abnormal and emergency scenarios.

This approach meets the international standard ISO 14001 and provides the management framework where we set and review environmental objectives and targets. We are therefore fully committed to continual improvement of our environmental management performance through the following policy commitments:

- Raise environmental awareness and communicate the environmental policy in such a way that it is understood by employees and others that work with us.
- It is also communicated to our clients to encourage best practice
- Develop a culture in which protection of the environment is a common objective shared with clients, contractors, suppliers and partners, and the communities in which Clipfine operates
- Understand the sensitivities of customers, including the pressure s of growing and changing statutory and public concern about environmental issues, and assist them in demonstrating compliance with environmental best practice
- Identify opportunities to reduce any environmental impact of Clipfine's activities at an early stage by adopting suitable mitigating measures e.g. the use of noise of suppression equipment
- Require our suppliers to provide goods and services with the minimum adverse environmental impact, and give preference to environmentally aware suppliers whenever possible
- Make efficient and environmentally responsible use of energy, water and other natural resources
- We will only source from organizations wood based products that are legally harvested, not genetically modified, nor from forests with serious social conflicts.
- We will not source wood based products from uncertified high conservation value forests
- Employ sound and efficient waste management practices and maintain emergency procedures to deal effectively with any significant environmental hazards which may arise as a result of the activities
- Reduce the environmental impact of business travel and transport logistics
- Integrate the above environmental objectives into our day to day activities.
